Shock-absorbing padding on the backstrap helps protect your hand from recoil, while the Limbsaver® recoil pad helps reduce felt recoil. Includes a 1¼" slot rear sling loop, plus a stud on the underside for a QD sling swivel. Models available for the Remington 870, Mossberg 930 and Benelli M1014.
