Ching Specialty model is a 3-point sling developed by Eric Ching in cooperation with the Gunsight training school and is perfect for target shooting, competition and dangerous game hunting where fast, accurate shot placement is essential. Center strap locks around the shooter's upper arm for rock-solid stability without using a bipod. Works like a "Deliberate" sling, but much faster to use, and once it's preset, no further loop adjustments are necessary.
