The 192 Bullet Proof thumb safety can be activated with either hand - great for left-handed shooters or competitors when the course calls for weak-hand shooting. Gunsmith installation recommended.

- Test the trigger pull for smoothness and adjust as necessary through final polishing and cutting the relief angle on the sear.
- Ensure that the grip safety is functioning properly and prevents the hammer from falling unless properly engaged.
