Slide the mags onto the TriMag and secure them by tightening the stainless steel crossbolt with a slot-head screwdriver or even a coin. Loosen the bolt to release the magazines for single use again. Nylon mag pouch holds three factory 10/22® magazines clamped together by an Alangator TriMag coupler. Built with double-walled sides, double-stitched seams, and plastic inserts to hold its shape when inserting the TriMag pack. Oversized pull tab gives a secure grasp for easy opening of flap. Indexing slot ensures proper positioning of mag and coupler assembly during insertion. Snap-closure belt loop for easy mounting on belts up to 2¼" wide. Kit also available with three factory original 10-Round Magazines.

RUGER 10/22 10RD MAGAZINE Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RUGER 10/22 10RD MAGAZINE. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use of this product. Please read this manual carefully before using the magazine and keep it for future reference.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat all firearms and ammunition as if they are loaded.
- Keep the magazine out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Use only the recommended ammunition (22 Long Rifle) for this magazine.

2. Loading the Magazine:

- Insert one round of 22 Long Rifle ammunition into the magazine, ensuring it is seated properly.
- Repeat until the magazine is loaded to the maximum capacity of 10 rounds.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Open the action of the firearm to ensure it is empty.
- Press the magazine release button on the firearm while pulling the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Using the TriMag Coupler:

- Slide the magazines onto the TriMag coupler.
- Secure the magazines by tightening the stainless steel crossbolt using a slothead screwdriver or a coin.
- Loosen the bolt to release the magazines for single use if needed.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
- If the magazine is damaged or no longer in use, do not discard it in regular trash.
