Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the ORING CLEANING JAGS TCS .410 BORE CLEANING JAG. This product is designed to effectively clean the bore of your firearm while ensuring the safety of both the user and the equipment. - Ensure that the patch is firmly seated against the Oring for effective cleaning.

4. Cleaning the Bore

- Insert the cleaning jag gently into the bore of the firearm.
- Use a smooth, steady motion to push the jag through the bore and then pull it back out.
- Repeat this process as necessary, changing patches when they become soiled.

5. PostCleaning

- After cleaning, remove the cleaning jag from the cleaning rod.
- Dispose of used patches and any cleaning materials according to local regulations.
- Store the cleaning jag and other cleaning supplies in a safe location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any used cleaning patches, steel wool, and bronze wool in accordance with local waste disposal regulations.
- If the cleaning jag is damaged beyond repair, dispose of it responsibly by following local electronic waste guidelines.
