Redesigned thumb lever lock retains zero even after repeated optic removal and reinstallation. Ability to stake position for extreme duty. AKML allows the mounting of the Aimpoint T-1 and H-1 Micro Red Dot Optics AKOG allows the mounting of Trijicon ACOG sight systems

- To field strip the rifle, follow the manufacturer's instructions for your specific AK variant.
- The optic can remain mounted during this process for most AK variants.
- After field stripping, check the optic mount and optic for any misalignment or damage.

4. Maintenance

- Regularly clean the optic mount with a soft cloth to remove dust and debris.
- Inspect the thumb lever lock and mounting hardware for wear and tear.
