Introduction

It is essential to follow safety guidelines to ensure safe and effective use. - Insert the trim chamber into the heavyduty trimmer body until it clicks into place.
- Secure the trimmer body into the $\frac{1}{2}$ " chuck of the drill.

- Set up your workspace in a clean, welllit area.
- Place the cartridge in the trimmer and ensure it is properly aligned.
- Turn on the drill at a low speed to start trimming.
- Gradually increase the speed as needed, but do not exceed recommended RPMs.
- Once trimming is complete, turn off the drill and carefully remove the cartridge.

3. PostUse Care:

- Clean the trimmer and trim chamber after each use to remove debris.

- Store the trimmer and all accessories in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the trimmer and any wornout accessories in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the trimmer in household waste; check for local recycling programs.
