The PSR was in response to the testing feedback that we got from the Military. These changes include a non-rotational legs, fore and aft pivot limiting bosses and a 40% stronger Inner leg. It is comprised of 6061-T6 aluminum, except the strengthened inner legs which are made from 7075-T6 aluminum that are Mil-Spec Type III hard coat anodized and have heat treated, stainless steel components.
