Introduction

- After installation, regularly check the tightness of the screws and the overall integrity of the scope rings during use.

4. PostUse Care

- After use, clean the scope rings and surrounding areas to prevent corrosion and maintain functionality.
- Store the firearm and scope rings in a dry, secure location.

Disposal Instructions

- When the scope rings reach the end of their life or are no longer functional, dispose of them in accordance with local regulations.
