Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 GEN II Extended Magazine Releases

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 GEN II Extended Magazine Release by ODIN Works Inc. This product is designed to enhance your shooting experience by providing a larger pushbutton surface area for faster and easier magazine release. To ensure your safety and the proper functioning of the product, please read and follow this safety instruction guide carefully.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
- Ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
- Store firearms and ammunition securely, out of reach of children and unauthorized users.

 - Make sure it releases the magazine without obstruction.

- To release the magazine, press the extended magazine release button firmly with your thumb.
- Ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction when releasing the magazine.
- After releasing the magazine, visually inspect the chamber to confirm it is clear.
