Their innovative cavity design and retention system allows them to be used ambidextrously with the double-stack magazines of nearly 100 different handgun models chambered in 9/40/357 Sig. They are available in singles or doubles, and have a body-hugging contour which is not only more comfortable than traditional magazine carriers; it is also more concealable. Shooters can also select between the standard tall body-style, which is compatible with all of Raven Concealments modular belt attachments, or short body-style which only works with their closed loops and QMS. Finally, you can buy one pistol magazine carrier that will work with nearly all the handguns in your collection! Safety Instruction Guide for COPIA SINGLE MAGAZINE CARRIER

Introduction

- With the other hand, pull the magazine upwards until it is free from the carrier.

5. Adjusting for Comfort:

- Adjust the positioning of the carrier as necessary for comfort and accessibility.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine carrier responsibly at a designated recycling or waste facility.
- Do not incinerate the carrier as it is made from injectionmolded polymer, which can release harmful substances when burned.
- Follow local regulations for the disposal of plastic products.
