Advanced Warfighter Magazines (AWM) fill the gap between the current metal and polymer magazine designs. These lightweight molded polymer magazines stand up to rough handling and extreme conditions of tactical operations, including heat and impact of sustained full-auto fire. Permanently attached, wrap-around feed lips are made from a single piece of precision formed, hardened steel that is PTFE coated for corrosion resistance. They help promote smooth ammo movement and will not deform when the magazine is stored fully loaded over a long period of time. Tested to withstand temperature extremes of -50 degrees F to +180 degrees F and a 5 foot drop fully loaded, onto concrete without impairment of function. Non-reflective exterior has molded-in ridges and enhanced texturing that improve the structural strength and provide a solid grasping surface. Drops free from mil-spec magwells; load to full capacity and insert into weapons with bolt closed. 30-round model fits pouches designed for standard US-GI-spec magazines. Anti-tilt follower and constant-radius body curve helps ensure smooth, snag-free feeding. Hard polymer base plate provides a positive gripping surface for extracting mag from tight-fitting pouches and removes easily for disassembly and cleaning.

Safety Instruction Guide for AR15 30RD L5AWM Opaque FDE Magazine

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 30RD L5AWM Opaque FDE Magazine by Lancer Systems. This guide provides important safety instructions and usage information to ensure safe handling and operation of the magazine. Please read this guide thoroughly before use.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat the magazine as if it is loaded.
- Keep the magazine out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Inspect the magazine for damage before each use. Do not use if damaged.
- Store the magazine in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- Follow all local laws and regulations regarding firearm accessories and ammunition.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Ensure that the firearm is pointed in a safe direction at all times when inserting or removing the magazine.
- Do not exceed the magazine's capacity of 30 rounds.
- Avoid dropping the magazine from heights greater than 5 feet, as this may impair its function.
- Do not use the magazine with ammunition types other than .223 Remington or 5.56 mm NATO.
- Regularly clean the magazine to prevent malfunctions. Refer to the cleaning instructions below.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Loading the Magazine:

- Hold the magazine with the feed lips facing upward.
- Insert the rounds into the magazine, ensuring that the bullets face the front.
- Load rounds until the magazine reaches its 30round capacity.

2. Inserting the Magazine:

- Ensure the firearm's bolt is closed.
- Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.
- Push the magazine firmly until it clicks into place.

3. Removing the Magazine:

- Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
- Grasp the magazine and pull it downward to remove it from the magazine well.

4. Disassembly and Cleaning:

- To disassemble, remove the base plate by pressing it down and sliding it off.
- Clean the interior and exterior of the magazine with a soft cloth and mild cleaning solution.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals that may damage the polymer material.
- Reassemble the magazine by replacing the base plate securely.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations regarding plastic waste.
- Do not burn the magazine as it may release harmful substances.
