The L7AWM is lightweight with steel feed lips that wrap completely around the magazine to maximize stiffness and reliability while preventing dimpling to the front of the magazine. A switchable drain lock in the floor plate comes standard on all L7s, allowing users to configure the magazine for either water-borne or extreme dust conditions. The L7AWM is designed to work in multiple weapon systems. Will NOT fit AR10, SCAR17 or HK417 FITS: SR25, DPMS, LM308, SIG 716, LARUE OBR or ROBINSON XCR

# **Safety Instruction Guide for AR 308 L7AWM Translucent Dark Earth 10Round Magazines**

## **Introduction**

Thank you for choosing the AR 308 L7AWM Translucent Dark Earth 10Round Magazines by Lancer Systems. This guide provides essential safety information and instructions to ensure the proper use and handling of your magazine. Please read this guide carefully before use.

- Avoid exposing the magazine to extreme temperatures or harsh chemicals.
- Do not attempt to modify or disassemble the magazine.

## **Instructions for Installation and Usage**

### **1. Loading the Magazine**

- Firmly push the magazine into the well until it clicks into place.
- Verify that the magazine is securely attached before proceeding.

### **3. Removing the Magazine**

- Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction and is on safety.
- Press the magazine release button while pulling down on the magazine to remove it from the firearm.
- Store the magazine in a safe location after removal.

### **4. Cleaning and Maintenance**

- Regularly clean the magazine to ensure optimal performance.

- Use a soft cloth to wipe the exterior and a brush to clean the feed lips.
- Avoid using abrasive materials that could damage the magazine.
