The checkered round button is taller and wider than the factory Mark IV™ button, but low enough so shooters with large hands won't accidentally activate it. The grooved, paddle-style button extends back toward the shooter, so it's just the ticket for juniors or other shooters with short thumbs. You can even angle the paddle up or down to position it in the sweet spot that's best for you. Easy installation - if you can read instructions & field strip a pistol, YOU can install the Titan Ideal for young shooters, competition shooters, or shooters with small hands. Robust steel and anodized aluminum construction for years of service. Deeply textured surfaces for non-slip finger contact. The Tandemkross Titan Extended Magazine Release for Ruger® Mark IV™ comes in black or silver, so you can get it in a color that matches - or contrasts with - your Ruger® rimfire pistol. Safety Instruction Guide for RUGER® MARK IV™ "TITAN" EXTENDED MAGAZINE RELEASE

Introduction
