Safety Instruction Guide for MAGAZINE 9MM FOR GLOCK® 19, 26 KCI USA

Introduction

- Pull the magazine out of the magazine well.

4. Care and Maintenance:

- Regularly clean the magazine to ensure proper function.

- Use a soft cloth to wipe down the polymer body and remove any debris.
- Inspect the spring and follower for wear and replace if necessary.
