Try loading it to half capacity and leaving overnight to help set up the spring and make it easier to insert a full load later. Polymer body with stainless steel insert tube Baseplate is easy to remove for cleaning Witness holes for instance ammo status checks Accepts magazine accessories that fit factory mags Fits Gen3 & Gen4 Glock® 22 & 23 pistols The KCI 31-round magazine brings compatibility to the table, too: it will fit all Gen3 and Gen4 Glock 22 and 23 pistols with an ambidextrous mag release. Introduction
