The PPT's tool head is drilled and tapped to accept four standard 8-32 thread, screw-on case prep tools - no switching between different tools or swapping cutters. You keep the Precision Prep Tool in your hand and simply perform up to four prep steps, one after the other. Unlike other prep tools that require you to twist your wrist or rotate the tool, the Precision Prep Tool's offset head only needs a simple rotation of your forearm to chamfer, deburr, clean the primer pocket, and de-crimp military brass.
