# HELLFIRE WRENCH Safety Instructions

## Introduction

  - Turn the wrench clockwise until tight, but do not overtighten.
- To loosen a stuck mount:
  - Position the external hex over the stuck mount.
  - Turn the wrench counterclockwise to loosen.

### 3. PostUse Care

- Clean the tool after use to remove any debris or residue.
- Store the HELLFIRE WRENCH in a safe, dry place away from direct sunlight.

## Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the HELLFIRE WRENCH in accordance with local regulations.
- If the tool is damaged beyond repair, consider recycling materials where applicable.
