The cup is machined from 6061 billet aluminum and weights just over 700 grains. It is designed to hold more than 750 grains of powder. Simply place it underneath the powder dispenser and ensure that each stray grain of powder is captured during dispensing. The cup measures 2 inches in diameter and 2 inches tall and features a 3-inch handle.
