The attachment areas are machined to the exact specifications of a Remington 700 receiver for a perfect fit, and the unit features a unique ejection-port cut that facilitates seamless operation. Machined from 7075 aluminum Matte-black finish Fits all Picatinny-style attachments Each Area 419 Remington 700 Short Action Scope Rail can be had in two configurations: Full Slotted and ARC Top. Full Slotted rails enable use with all standard Picatinny scope mounts, while the ARC is a proprietary Area 419 design that features enhanced aesthetics but is not compatible with Spuhr or MPA mounts.

Consumer Safety Instruction Guide for REMINGTON 700 SHORT ACTION SCOPE RAILS AREA 419

Introduction
