A hardened steel screw goes through the barrel's link pin holes to retain it in a cutout on the base. Another slot provides plenty of clearance to access the hood with the proper file. (File not included, but we offer plenty of gunsmithing files separately.) Also included: a nylon strap to cinch the barrel down while you work. Rugged aluminum & steel construction for a lifetime of service Accepts ALL 1911 barrels - even bull barrels Base can be clamped in a bench vise for rock-steady support The 1911 Barrel Fitting Jig from Apex Tactical seems so simple, yet provides you with a substantial leg up in achieving perfect barrel-to-slide lockup. 1911 Barrel Fitting Jig Safety Instructions

Introduction
