When installed on a Glock G19, the overall profile of the gun matches the footprint of the Glock G34, and the system will fit most G34 holsters. Though the Zev V2 PRO Compensator was designed for the G19, the system will work on all 9mm Glock handgun barrels with the same thread pitch. The company recommends matching recoil-spring weight to your pistol and ammunition type for the best possible performance. Available thread pitches are 1/2x28 TPI and 13.5x1mm

Safety Instruction Guide for PRO COMPENSATOR V2 FOR GLOCK®
