Each trigger is constructed from polymer and is built with a factory-tuned OEM Glock trigger bar for enhanced performance. Syndicate Polymer Triggers are available for a range of Glock models, including Gens 1-4 of the G17, G19, G22, G23, G26, G27, G31, G32, G33, G34 and G35. Owners of Gen 5 Glock pistols can also get in on the enhancement, thanks to fits for the Gen 5 G17, G19, G19X, G26, G34 and G45.

Safety Instruction Guide for SYNDICATE POLYMER TRIGGER

Introduction
