The magazine is designed for use with Glock- or Colt-pattern bolt-carrier groups. The product functions with all standard 9mm ammunition and will fit with all accessories designed for use with Magpul PMAGs.

AR9 Endomags 9MM 10Round Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR9 Endomags 9MM 10Round magazine. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your product. It is important to read and understand these instructions before using the magazine.
