The Mean Arms MA-Lock is designed to fix magazines into place on today's mil-spec AR-15 and AR .308 rifles, allowing owners to comply with state and local laws while keeping ownership of their guns. The Mean Arms MA-Lock replaces the magazine release and corresponding spring. Once a 10-round magazine is inserted, simply install the bushing into the magazine-release receiver hole and then tighten the hex-shaped head until it shears off. This will leave the magazine permanently fixed into the magazine well. In conjunction with this feature, Mean Arms also offers its MA-Loader, which allows owners of fixed-magazine rifles to quickly and easily load 10 rounds into the magazine through the ejection port of their rifle. The loader works with all mil-spec AR upper receivers.

# AR10/AR15 MA Lock Safety Instruction Guide

## Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Mean Arms AR10/AR15 MA Lock. This product is designed to help you comply with state and local laws regarding magazine restrictions while maintaining the functionality of your tactical rifle. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure proper use and installation of the MA Lock, as well as to understand how to safely handle your firearm.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- Keep firearms pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- Ensure that your firearm is securely stored and out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Always wear appropriate eye and ear protection when handling firearms.

- Do not attempt to remove the MA Lock once it has been installed, as it permanently fixes the magazine in place.
- Always use caution when handling tools during installation to avoid injury.
- If you are unsure about the installation process, seek assistance from a qualified gunsmith.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Preparation

- Ensure your rifle is unloaded.
- Gather the necessary tools: a hex wrench for tightening the bushing.

### 2. Installation of the MA Lock

- Insert a 10round magazine into the magazine well of your rifle.
- Locate the magazinerelease receiver hole.
- Insert the bushing into the magazinerelease receiver hole.
- Use the hex wrench to tighten the hexshaped head of the bushing until it shears off. This will permanently fix the magazine in place.
- Verify that the magazine is securely fixed and cannot be removed.

### 3. Using the MALoader

- To load rounds into the fixed magazine, use the Mean Arms MALoader.
- Insert the MALoader into the ejection port of your rifle.
- Follow the instructions provided with the MALoader to load 10 rounds into the magazine quickly and easily.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of any packaging materials in accordance with local regulations.
- If the MA Lock is no longer needed, it should be handled as per local waste disposal guidelines for firearms accessories. Contact local waste management for specific instructions.
