Without the user-installed stock or grip, the chassis weighs in at a scant 1 pound, 11 ounces. Made entirely in the USA, the Midwest Industries Ruger PC Carbine Takedown Chassis is machined from 6061 aluminum and features a hard-coat anodized finish and two anti-rotation QD sling sockets. All the tools and mounting hardware required for installation are included with the stock.
