Despite the additional strength, the minimalist design weighs only 4 oz. In this case, minimalist does not mean feature free. The stock can be adjusted out to three positions to create a more custom fit for the shooter. Ambidextrous QD swivels are built in for a strong, integrated solution. The orbital stock shape, introduced with the PDW Stock, creates an ergonomic, secure shoulder weld, even in the unorthodox shooting positions characteristic of vehicle born, or extreme close quarters conditions the form factor is designed to dominate. Pair with the upcoming Enhanced Pistol Grip (PDW angle) for the ultimate ultra-compact, yet ergonomic, AR15. Note: The Strike Pit Stock is only compatible with Strike Industries 7 Position Advanced Receiver Extension. Not compatible with any other manufacturer's buffer tube. Sold separately.

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AR15 Pit Stock by Strike Industries. This guide provides essential safety instructions and guidelines to ensure the safe use of this product. Please read this manual carefully before installation and use.

- Be aware of your surroundings and the environment in which you are shooting, especially in close quarters or vehicle settings.
- Use the ambidextrous QD swivels only as intended. Do not overload or misuse these components.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. Ensure that the firearm is unloaded and pointed in a safe direction.
2. Remove the existing stock from the buffer tube if applicable.
3. Align the Pit Stock with the Strike Industries 7 Position Advanced Receiver Extension.
4. Securely attach the Pit Stock by following the manufacturer's instructions for installation.
5. Confirm that the stock is locked in place and does not rattle.

Usage

- Adjust the stock to your preferred length by selecting one of the three available positions.
- Ensure a proper shoulder weld by positioning the stock securely against your shoulder.
- Utilize the ergonomic design of the stock for improved comfort during extended use.
- Maintain control of the firearm at all times and avoid any unintentional discharges.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the Pit Stock in accordance with local regulations regarding firearm accessories.
- If the product is damaged or no longer usable, ensure it is disposed of safely to prevent unauthorized use.
