The TCS Sling is a 2-1 point convertible sling designed to function on CAR-15 / M4 variants and a wide variety of other long guns. It can be converted from 2 point to 1 point sling formats in seconds and back again just as easily. It features three (3) 3/8" wide shock cords sleeved at the rear end of the sling that allow you to sling up a little tighter, yet easily cross shoulder transition. The shock cords also give you the benefit of shock absorption during aggressive movement. The TCS Sling also features a side release buckle assembly that is intended to stay attached to the weapon at all times. The female portion of the side release buckle is permanently attached to the sling itself. With the male portion of the side release buckle attached to the weapon, and the female portion attached to the sling, the sling remains wrapped around the operator's body when the release buckle is disengaged. This is the key feature of this design. If it becomes necessary to unhook the weapon from your body, such as when firing from an unconventional shooting position outside of the capabilities of the sling or something as simple, yet hazardous, as mounting/dismounting a vehicle, there isn't 3 feet of webbing trailing from the weapon. This allows the operator a much greater degree of versatility and safety. Note: You must have some form of side mounted front sling loop, hook or swivel and a receiver mounted QD swivel socket for this sling to mount to. Safety Instruction Guide for the CONVERTIBLE 1 OR 2 POINT TACTICAL SLINGS

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the CONVERTIBLE 1 OR 2 POINT TACTICAL SLINGS by SPECTER GEAR. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use of your tactical sling. Please read this guide carefully before using the product.

General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that you understand the functionality of the sling and how to convert it between 1point and 2point configurations.

- Locate the sidemounted front sling loop, hook, or swivel on your firearm.

- Adjust the length of the sling using the 1" MilW43668 adjuster strap to fit comfortably across your shoulder.
- Ensure that the webbing is not twisted and that the adjuster strap is functioning correctly.

Usage

1. Converting Between Sling Configurations:

- To switch from a 2point to a 1point configuration, simply detach the sling from the rear attachment point and reattach it to the designated 1point attachment.
- Reverse the process to convert back to a 2point configuration.

2. Using the Sling:

- When using the sling, ensure that it is snug but not overly tight, allowing for comfortable movement.
- Utilize the shock cords for added stability and shock absorption during movement.

3. Emergency Release:

- In case of emergency, utilize the Emergency Release Buckle (ERB) to quickly detach the sling from your body.
- Practice the release mechanism to ensure familiarity before engaging in any activities.

- When the sling reaches the end of its usable life or is damaged beyond repair, dispose of it responsibly.
