The sights are made of tough, durable polymer and are adjustable for both windage and elevation. The front sight band is dimensioned to allow clearance for magazine extensions or other accessories, and fits barrels with bead or bead/pedestal base sights. The Saddle Sights are the perfect addition to a 3-Gun, home defense, or deer hunting shotgun.
