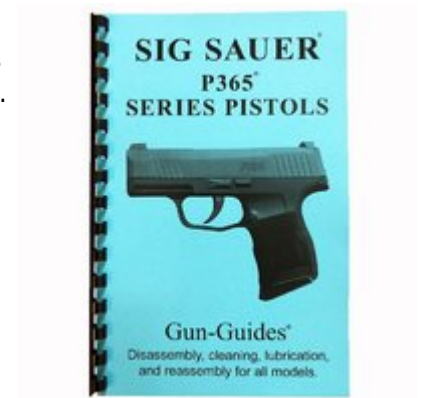

Introduction
