These Classic Tritium Rear Sights for Glock handguns are available in a green/white color configuration and feature a sight body machined from steel for durability. The sight fits the following Glock handgun models: 17, 19, 22, 23, 26, 27, 33, 34, 35, 37, 38 and 39.
