Anti-slip finger grooves on both sides of the magazine help give positive control when inserting the magazine. The low-profile design makes it easy to insert and remove in a double or even triple stack magazine pouch setup. Safety Instruction Guide for the AR15 Magazine Polymer 5.56mm

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Strike Industries AR15 33Round Magazine. This guide provides essential safety instructions to ensure the safe use and handling of your magazine. Please read this manual carefully before use to understand how to operate and maintain the magazine safely.

- Reassemble the magazine once it is clean and dry.
