The padding encasement is constructed out of 500d Cordura and has a minimal seam that ensures that there are no rough edges that will rub the users neck raw. We do not use biding to close the encasement which can rub your neck raw after prolonged usage. Open looped ends allow the user to add whatever mounting hardware is needed to fit their needs.
