Like all Magpul bolt action magazines, it features a paint-pen dot matrix for visual identification and a flared base plate for positive control and ease of retrieval. Designed from the ground up to solve the challenges of feeding 5.56/.223, the PMAG 10 5.56 AC sets a new standard for bolt action magazine technology.

Compatible with short action AICS-pattern bottom metal and 5.56x45 NATO/.223 Remington cartridges. Use with other calibers such as .300 AAC Blackout is not recommended. AICS SHORT ACTION PMAG 10 5.56AC Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the AICS SHORT ACTION PMAG 10 5.56AC by Magpul. This magazine is designed for reliable performance in short action AICSpattern firearms. To ensure safe and effective use, please read and follow these safety instructions carefully.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always handle all firearms and magazines with care and respect.
- Ensure the magazine is empty before handling or installing it into a firearm.
- Store magazines in a secure location, out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Regularly inspect the magazine for signs of wear or damage. Do not use if damaged.
- Use only compatible cartridges (5.56x45 NATO/.223 Remington). Using incorrect ammunition can lead to malfunctions or injury.
- Report any unsafe products or accidents to local authorities immediately.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- **Age Restrictions:** This product is intended for adult use. Keep out of reach of children.
- **Compatibility:** Only use with short action AICSpattern bottom metal. Using with incompatible systems may result in malfunction.
- **Loading and Unloading:** Always load and unload the magazine in a safe environment, away from others. Ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- **Visual Inspection:** Before use, visually inspect the magazine for foreign objects or obstructions.
- **Avoid Modifications:** Do not modify the magazine. Alterations can compromise safety and functionality.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Loading the Magazine:

- Push the magazine firmly into place until it clicks.
- Confirm the magazine is securely attached before proceeding.

3. Using the Magazine:

- Fire the firearm according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- After firing, if the magazine needs to be removed, ensure the firearm is pointed in a safe direction.
- Press the magazine release button and remove the magazine.

4. Unloading the Magazine:

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Carefully unload each cartridge by pushing it out from the top.
- Store the magazine in a safe location once unloaded.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the magazine in accordance with local regulations.
