Made from 4140 Alloy Steel and heat treated to HRC 32 with a black nitride finish. With a low cost, the action wrench heads are quick and tool-less allowing the end user to have one tool that can work on most actions, without compromise. Actions that do not utilize a counterbore on the barrel face will come with a short front bumper to properly locate it in the action. Simply select the appropriate model number for the action you wish to use. If you do not see your action listed, please contact SAC, they are always developing new action wrench heads and some actions may work with certain models.  - Model 4: BAT Machine TR and similar actions.
 - Model 5: Tikka T3.
 - Model 6: Howa 1500, Borden, Kelbly's, Savage® actions.

- Model 7: Bighorn TL, SR, Origin (ejector must be removed), Gunwerks GLR Left and Right, Savage Small Shank.
- Model 8: American Rifle Company Nucleus/Archimedes.
- Model 9: Curtis Custom (not compatible with Terminus).
- Model 10: Defiance Elite, Pierce, Tuebor Raider.
- Model 11: Defiance .750" diameter bolts, Surgeon XL.
- Model 12: Sako A7.
- Model 13: Surgeon 591.
- Model 14: Terminus actions (compatible with Curtis Customs).
- Model 15: Sako TRG.
- Model 20: McMillan TAC50.

2. **Installation:**

- Ensure that the action is secured in a stable position.
- Attach the selected wrench head to the action, ensuring a tight fit.
- If using bumpers, ensure they are correctly positioned to prevent slippage.

3. **Usage:**

- Apply torque gradually and evenly to avoid damaging the action or wrench head.
- Always maintain a firm grip on the tool during use.
- If resistance is felt, stop and reassess the fitment to prevent damage.

4. **PostUse Care:**

- Clean the wrench heads after use to remove debris and prevent corrosion.
