Introduction

- Do not exceed the magazine capacity of 3 rounds for Long Action.

3. Unloading the Magazine:

- Remove the magazine from the firearm.
- Press the magazine release button and allow the magazine to drop free.
- Remove any remaining rounds from the magazine carefully.

4. Maintenance:

- Regularly inspect the magazine for wear and tear.
- Clean the magazine with a dry cloth to remove any debris or dirt.
- Store the magazine in a cool, dry place when not in use.
