Safety Instruction Guide for .920 BULL THREAD PROTECTOR 1/228

Introduction

Thank you for choosing the .920 Bull Thread Protector from Yankee Hill Machine Co., Inc. This product is designed to protect your rifle's muzzle threads and crown from damage. Please read this safety instruction guide carefully to ensure safe and effective use of the product.

- If it is difficult to remove, apply penetrating oil and allow it to sit before attempting again.

4. PostInstallation Check

- After installation, check to ensure the thread protector is securely attached.
- Regularly inspect the thread protector for wear and tear.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the thread protector in accordance with local regulations.
- If the thread protector is damaged or no longer usable, do not throw it in regular waste. Check for recycling options or hazardous waste disposal facilities.
