PRO 1000 Progressive Press Safety Instructions

Introduction

General Safety Guidelines

- Always check that a case is present in the shell plate before feeding primers and powder.
- Never look down the barrel or the case while reloading.
- Keep hands and tools clear of moving parts during operation to avoid injury.
- If a malfunction occurs, stop using the press immediately and consult the troubleshooting section of the manual.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

Installation

1. **Choose a Suitable Location:** Find a stable, flat surface for mounting the press. Ensure it is away from distractions and hazards.
2. **Mount the Press:** Use bolts to securely attach the press to the work surface. Ensure it is tightly fastened to prevent movement.
3. **Install the Turret:** Carefully place the Lee 3 Hole Turret onto the press, ensuring it fits snugly.
4. **Set Up the Shell Plate:** Attach the appropriate shell plate for your caliber to the press.
5. **Install the Powder Measure:** Attach the Pro AutoDisk powder measure according to the manufacturer's instructions.
