Introduction

2. Using the Cutter and Lock Stud:

- Attach the cutter to the lock stud.
- If using an electric drill, insert the lock stud into the drill.
- Position the case length gauge securely and insert the brass casing into the cutter.
- Activate the drill or manually turn the cutter to trim the brass casing to the desired length.

3. Chamfering:

- Use the chamfer tool to chamfer the inside and outside of the case necks.
- Apply light pressure while rotating the tool to achieve a smooth finish.

4. Cleaning Primer Pockets:

- Select the appropriate end of the doubleended primer pocket cleaner for your brass casing.
- Insert the cleaner into the primer pocket and rotate gently to remove debris.

5. PostUsage:

- Clean the tools with a soft cloth after use to remove any brass residue.
- Store all components in a safe location.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any used or damaged components of the kit in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the kit in regular household waste. Check for local recycling programs for metal and plastic.
