Steel Models uses unique internal Oval Nut plates specifically designed to fit the contour of four popular M14/M1A stocks. Once the nut plate is installed the rail can be installed or removed without rifle disassembly using two external screws through counter bored holes in the rail. Choose your Front Rail based upon your stock style, i.e. Universal, Wood, Fiberglass, Synthetic or Supermatch. The internal nut plate supplied with the Steel model is significantly stronger than screws and washers and will take the additional load from the bipod without danger of splitting or cracking the stock. Detailed installation instructions provided. Screws, Washers and nutplate included.

# M1A LowProfile Front Rails Safety Instruction Guide

## Introduction
