The change is a new one piece backend, which comes standard with tool-less buttpad height and cant adjustment, as well as an ambidextrous cheekpiece thumbscrew. All KRG's chassis take AICS magazines with nothing extra needed, the magazine is not included. Note: Actions with trigger hangers will not work without mods to the chassis, hanger, or both.
