A Backpacker Stock for Your Ruger PC Carbine

When the Backpacker Stock first emerged for the popular Ruger 10/22®, enthusiasts flocked to the streamlined design that made takedown models of the 10/22 easy to carry. Now, that same functionality is available to owners of the Ruger PC Carbine®, which operates with the same quick-takedown mechanism as the 10/22. This Magpul Backpacker Stock provides ultimate portability and provides many of the same features found in the original X-22 Backpacker. You'll find the same interface that locks the two separate halves of the gun together for transport and storage, and there are M-LOK attachment slots on the forend that make adding accessories a breeze.

Ruger® models equipped with chassis and/or tubular handguards utilize a Modular Handguard Mount which will need to be replaced by the end user with a standard Takedown Block in order to mount the Magpul Forend. Each Magpul PC Carbine® Backpacker Stock includes two storage locations, one found in the water-resistant grip and the other in the cheek riser that accommodates storage for a single pistol magazine. The size of this rear compartment will accommodate magazines up to the size of Magpul's PMA 21 GL9. This drop-in stock fit is designed to work with PC Carbines chambered in 9mm and .40 S&W, and there are interchangeable cheek risers that will work for mounted optics. A non-slip rubber butt pad ensures shooting comfort, and you can add an additional 3/8-inch insert to adjust the length-of-pull.

Ruger PC Carbine Backpacker Stocks Safety Instructions

Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Ruger PC Carbine Backpacker Stock by Magpul. This guide provides important safety information to ensure the safe use of your product. Please read this document carefully before using the Backpacker Stock.

General Safety Guidelines

- Always treat your firearm as if it is loaded.
- Keep the firearm pointed in a safe direction at all times.
- Store your firearm and ammunition separately in a secure location.
- Ensure that the firearm is unloaded when installing or removing the Backpacker Stock.
- Regularly inspect your firearm and accessories for wear or damage.
- Use only compatible accessories and parts as specified by the manufacturer.
- Follow all local laws and regulations regarding firearm ownership and usage.
- Be aware of your surroundings and ensure that your shooting area is safe and free from obstructions.

Specific Safety Precautions for Use

- Ensure that the Backpacker Stock is securely attached to the Ruger PC Carbine before use.
- Do not exceed the recommended weight limit for accessories attached to the MLOK attachment slots.
- Use caution when adjusting the lengthofpull with the rubber butt pad insert.

- Store any magazines in the designated storage area only when not in use.

- Avoid using the firearm in wet or slippery conditions to prevent accidents.

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. Installation of the Backpacker Stock:

- Ensure the Ruger PC Carbine is unloaded and the action is open.
- Remove the existing stock if applicable.
- Align the Backpacker Stock with the receiver of the Ruger PC Carbine.
- Securely attach the stock by following the manufacturer's instructions.
- Confirm that the stock is locked in place before proceeding.

2. Adjusting the LengthofPull:

- Remove the rubber butt pad from the stock.
- If desired, insert the additional 3/8inch insert to adjust the lengthofpull.
- Reattach the rubber butt pad securely.

3. Using the MLOK Attachment Slots:

- Select the desired accessory compatible with MLOK.
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for attaching the accessory to the forend.
- Ensure that the accessory is securely fastened before use.

4. Storage of Magazines:

- Insert a single pistol magazine into the storage compartment located in the cheek riser.
- Ensure that the magazine is seated properly and that the compartment is closed.

5. Transporting the Firearm:

- When transporting the firearm, ensure that the Backpacker Stock is securely locked and the firearm is unloaded.
- Use a suitable case to protect the firearm during transport.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of the Backpacker Stock and any associated materials in accordance with local regulations.
- Do not dispose of the product in regular household waste.
- If the product is damaged or no longer usable, contact your local waste management facility for proper disposal methods.
