This two-die set is for 30-06 Springfield cases used in tight-chambering semi-automatic, pump or lever-action rifles. It consists of a Small Base Sizer with an Expander-Decapping Unit and Regular Seater Die with Seater Plug. The sizer resizes cases below SAAMI minimums, reducing the shoulder and body by a few thousandths. It also de-primers the case. The included Seater Die has a built-in roll crimping to secure the bullet at the same time it's seated. To seat bullets without crimping, simply unscrew the die until the crimp ring no longer engages the case mouth.

# Safety Instruction Guide for RCBS 3006 Springfield Small Base Die Set

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the RCBS 3006 Springfield Small Base Die Set. This guide provides important safety information and instructions for the safe use of this product. Please read and follow all instructions carefully to ensure your safety and the proper functioning of the die set.

## Instructions for Installation and Usage

### 1. Setup:

- Securely mount your reloading press according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Ensure the press is stable and positioned on a sturdy workbench.

### 2. Installation of the Die Set:

- Start with the Small Base Sizer Die:
  - Remove the die from its packaging.
  - Screw the die into the press until it is snug but not overly tight.
  - Insert the ExpanderDecapping Unit into the die.
- Install the Regular Seater Die:
  - Remove the die from its packaging.
  - Screw the die into the press until it is snug but not overly tight.
  - Insert the Seater Plug into the die.

### 3. Resizing Cases:

- Place a 3006 Springfield case into the shell holder.
- Raise the ram to engage the sizer die.
- Lower the ram to complete the sizing process.

- Remove the resized case and check for proper dimensions.

#### **4. Seating Bullets:**

- Insert a resized case into the shell holder.
- Place a bullet on top of the case mouth.
- Raise the ram to engage the seater die.
- Lower the ram to seat the bullet.
- If crimping is desired, ensure the crimp ring engages the case mouth; otherwise, adjust the die as needed.

#### **5. Final Check:**

- Inspect each completed round for proper bullet seating and overall dimensions.
- Store completed ammunition in a safe and secure location.

## **Disposal Instructions**

- Dispose of any damaged or unusable reloading components according to local regulations.
- Do not throw away the die set in regular trash. Instead, check with local waste management for proper disposal methods for metal and plastic components.
