Introduction

Instructions for Installation and Usage

- Insert rounds into the magazine one at a time, ensuring they are seated properly.
- Do not force rounds into the magazine, as this may cause jams.

2. Inserting the Magazine into the Firearm:

- With the magazine oriented correctly, slide it into the magazine well until it clicks into place.
