In addition to its smaller size, the Magpul PMAG 20 AR 300 B design gives you a safer way to shoot. Since the 300 Blackout functions in 5.56 NATO magazines and vice-versa, the risk of chambering a 300 Blackout round in your 5.56 NATO rifle is higher, and that can lead to a catastrophic malfunction. This PMAG has been designed with a distinct look and feel that allows you to tell the difference both by sight and feel to avoid sticking the wrong magazine into your gun. Each Magpul PMAG 20 AR 300 B design is made from Magpul's durable, rugged polymer and features an easy-to-remove baseplate for cleaning. You'll also get a dot matrix for organization, as well as a dust cover that also protects your feed lips from impacts. Like all of Magpul's products, this magazine is made right here in the USA.

# Safety Instruction Guide for Magpul PMAG 20 AR 300 B GEN M3

## Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Magpul PMAG 20 AR 300 B GEN M3. This magazine is designed for use with .300 AAC Blackout rounds and is compatible with AR15 platforms. To ensure safe usage and compliance with the EU General Product Safety Regulation (GPSR), please read this safety instruction guide carefully.

## General Safety Guidelines

- Ensure that the magazine is used only with compatible firearms.
- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for use and maintenance.
- Store the magazine in a safe and secure location, out of reach of children and unauthorized users.
- Regularly inspect the magazine for any signs of damage or wear.

4. Close the magazine by replacing the baseplate if it was removed for loading.

2. Align the magazine with the magazine well of the firearm.

2. Press the magazine release button on the firearm.
3. Pull the magazine downward to remove it from the magazine well.

4. Reassemble the magazine after cleaning and ensure it is dry before use.
