Collet lets you adjust the shaft length approximately 3" to get to those hard-to-reach places. Rotating cap minimizes friction to ease screw removal or installation, while the hanging hole in the handle can be used with a second shaft as a T-handle for extra leverage to remove stubborn screws. Handle has a soft, ergonomic, rubber outer-grip for comfort and excellent grip.

Safety Instruction Guide for the Bondhus Precision Screwdriver Kit

Introduction

- Insert a new bit and push the shaft back into the collet until it clicks.

4. Using the Thandle Feature:

- If additional leverage is needed, insert a second shaft into the hanging hole of the handle.
- Use this Thandle for better grip and torque when removing stubborn screws.
