Knurled gripping surface makes it easy to install and remove the choke without special tools. Precision machined from 1704 stainless steel for maximum strength, then treated with a manganese phosphate finish for improved wear resistance. Models available for Beretta/Benelli shotguns, 12 gauge only. Can be used with lead, buckshot, hevishot, or steel shot without damage.
