Thick, 1", rubber pad takes the punishment out heavy recoil for more enjoyable shooting. Contender includes fixed, sling loops at grip and tang area to accommodate over-the-shoulder, behind the back, and ready-carry positions, plus a checkered, non-slip pistol grip.

Introduction
