SKS Scope Mount Safety Instruction Guide

Introduction

- Position the SKS scope mount on the receiver of the firearm, aligning it with the desired sight line.
- Mark the drilling points for the mounting holes, ensuring they are centered and spaced correctly:
 - Hole spacing: 3" centertocenter between the outer mounting holes.
 - Hole spacing: 2" between the inner mounting holes.
- Drill the marked holes carefully, following the appropriate drill size for the 840 screws.
- Tap the drilled holes to create threads for the screws.
- Align the scope mount with the drilled holes and insert the four 840 screws.
- Tighten the screws securely, ensuring not to overtighten.

3. Usage:

- Once installed, you can use the scope mount while still being able to clean your SKS as normal.
- Always verify that the scope is securely mounted before using the firearm.
- Regularly check the tightness of the screws, especially after extended use.

Disposal Instructions

- Dispose of any packaging materials responsibly, following local recycling guidelines.
- If the product is no longer in use, consider recycling it at a designated facility or returning it to the manufacturer if applicable.
