Tolerance are +.0000/-0.0002 22 CF (184-000-067) standard bushing on reamer is .2190 (+.0000/-0.0002) - bushing pack to include one each .2186 and .2194 bushings 6mm (184-000-070) standard bushing on reamer is .2360 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2356 and .2364 bushings 25 cal (184-000-073) standard bushing on reamer is .2500 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2496 and .2504 bushings 6.5mm (184-000-068) standard bushing on reamer is .2560 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2556 and .2564 bushings 270 cal (184-000-071) standard bushing on reamer is .2700 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2696 and .2704 bushings 7mm (184-000-072) standard bushing on reamer is .2760 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2756 and .2764 bushings 30 cal (184-000-069) standard bushing on reamer is .3000 (+.0000/-0.0002) -bushing pack to include one each .2996 and .3004 bushings

 - 270 cal: .2700 (+.0000/.0002)
 - 7mm: .2760 (+.0000/.0002)
 - 30 cal: .3000 (+.0000/.0002)
- Do not attempt to modify or alter the bushings in any way.
- Ensure that you are using the correct size bushing for your specific application:
 - 22 CF: .2186 and .2194 bushings included
 - 6mm: .2356 and .2364 bushings included
 - 25 cal: .2496 and .2504 bushings included
 - 6.5mm: .2556 and .2564 bushings included
 - 270 cal: .2696 and .2704 bushings included
 - 7mm: .2756 and .2764 bushings included
 - 30 cal: .2996 and .3004 bushings included

Instructions for Installation and Usage

1. **Preparation:** Ensure that the workspace is clean and welllit. Gather all necessary tools and equipment before starting.
2. **Selecting the Bushing:**
 - Identify the correct bushing size needed for your reamer.
 - Check the tolerance specifications to ensure compatibility.
3. **Installation:**
 - Carefully insert the selected bushing into the reamer.
